1 GE Slate Appliances

With gray finishes becoming more popular for appliances, GE expanded its Slate line with slide-in gas and electric ranges, wall ovens, electric cooktops, microwaves, and refrigerators. Microwave models include countertop or over-the-range convection microwaves, and refrigerator styles include counter-depth French door, French door bottom-freezer, 30-inch bottom freezer, and side-by-side.

2 Whirlpool Duet Steam Dryer

Whirlpool's Duet steam dryer is the first clothes dryer to comply with the new Energy Star requirements by requiring less heat to dry clothes. Advanced moisture sensors measure moisture content, ending the cycle precisely when the clothes are dry. This feature helps save energy and reduce wear on fabrics. The EcoBoost setting also utilizes those sensors with dual element modulation technology to adjust the heat output based on moisture content.

Thermador now offers a trimless version of its Freedom Induction Cooktop featuring a solid dark gray surface. The cooking surface—big enough for a 21-by-13-inch pan—can identify pot shape and size for precise heating anywhere through a series of 48 3-inch heating elements. PowerBoost heating—controlled on the 6.5-inch full-color touchscreen display—brings water to a boil faster. Spills and boil-overs can be wiped away without leaving scorch marks.

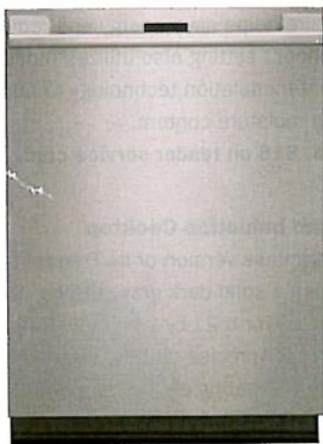
