



Lofty Accomplishments

LOOKING TO ADD some wow factor to her second-floor loft's kitchen, as well as increase the storage and seating in the limited space, this Royal Oak, Michigan, resident called on Nicole Pilon of KSI Kitchen and Bath.

Though the kitchen had an open and easy floor plan from the start, it also flowed directly into the nearby dining, living, and bedroom areas, meaning any changes in the kitchen needed to cohesively mesh with the existing furniture and décor throughout the loft. To accomplish this, Pilon and the loft owner chose a textured foil, frameless Dura Supreme cabinetry in a Cinder finish. To amp up the aesthetic, lift cabinets were installed above the sink in a client-picked vibrant Fresh Papaya high-gloss laminate that really gave the room some pop.

A custom-designed Dura Supreme island was incorporated to offer enough seating space for four. Plus, its built-in storage areas—including shelving, drawers, a double trash bin, pullout tray dividers, and outlets—provide plenty of room for pots, pans, silverware, and

even small appliances. In the end, Pilon was able to keep the kitchen's welcoming, open feel, while still giving the resident the storage space, seating area, and stunning aesthetic she needed to cook, dine, and entertain guests. «
